1. Rationale and Significance

The Eighth International Conference on Advancement of Development Administration 2019—Social Sciences and Interdisciplinary Studies (the 8th ICADA 2019—SSIS), hosted by the National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA), is inviting abstracts of review articles and/or research articles and full papers of review/research articles in social sciences and interdisciplinary studies. The theme of the 8th ICADA 2019 is “The Multidisciplinary Edge in the Disruptive World” including academically related issues. The aims of this conference are (1) to bring together international academics, professionals, and undergraduate/graduate students with the general public by providing a stage for the latest research in social sciences and interdisciplinary studies to be presented and discussed and (2) to provide a forum for professionals with practical experience of the social and economic development of developing countries to exchange their views and share their knowledge with leading countries.

“The Multidisciplinary Edge in the Disruptive World,” as the major theme, has interested those from all sectors, not only public sectors, but also private sectors. The theme refers to the phenomenon/situation today and in the future that is very complicated and unpredictable in all aspects. For that reason, the multidisciplinary edge is very crucial to help solve such problems which are in relations to global environment, society, politics, and business as well as economy now and in the future. These solutions may lead to a better way of life.

Major activities will be organized, including special lecture, academic dialogues, and presentations of faculty members, academics and undergraduate/graduate students. This conference is not only the dissemination of scholarly works, but also the presentation of Thai art/culture to non-Thai participants.

2. Objectives

2.1 To provide a public stage where academics, professionals, and university students can present their research at international level.

2.2 To facilitate an exchange of knowledge and academic/research experiences.

2.3 To encourage the development in academic researches with the purpose of supporting more effective learning and teaching processes as well as striving for the betterment in economics, society, and politics at both national and regional levels.

3. Conference Theme

The Eighth ICADA 2019—SSIS welcomes abstracts/papers related to development and administration, social sciences, and interdisciplinary studies with the major theme of “The Multidisciplinary Edge in the Disruptive World.” The abstracts/papers can be categorized into three categories: (1) the issues, (2) the disciplines/fields, and (3) the authors. 4. Type of Article

4.1 Abstracts of Review/Research Articles

The author(s) may submit ONLY an abstract(s) for presentation at the 8th ICADA 2019. The authors of qualified abstracts will be invited to give their presentations at the conference as well as for the conference document (not the Proceedings). In this case, no full paper submission must be made.

4.2 Full Papers of Review/Research Articles

Full papers will be qualified to be included in the Proceedings if (1) the author(s) submit his/her both abstract(s) and full paper(s) by the due dates given in item 6.2, (2) their works are peer reviewed and qualified by the selected reviewers, and (3) the author(s) give his/her/their presentations at the conference. (*See the Remarks.)

In order to ensure the quality is on par with universal standards, the abstracts of review/research articles and the full papers of review/research articles submitted to the 8th ICADA 2019 will be peer-reviewed by local and/or international scholars in their fields. Only the authors of qualified works will be invited to give a presentation at the conference. The qualified abstracts will be included in the Conference Document (not the Proceedings), while the qualified full papers will be published in the Proceedings of the conference. Also, a paper published in the Proceedings may be used as part of an annual report on job performance (weight 0.40) for a full time professor in a higher education institute in Thailand. Such a higher education institute must be under supervision of the Office for National Education Standard and Quality Assessment (Public Organization), Thailand.

The author(s) must also specify the discipline/field of the work (e.g., Law) under item 3.2, and type of article (abstract or full paper) under item 4 at the end of abstract. If there is no specification, these works will be categorized by the conference committee.

5. Format Instructions

All abstracts/full papers **must be typed in English and in the APA format (the 6th edition) only (<http://www.apa.org/>)**. The language use must be grammatically correct. The abstracts and/or full papers must be submitted by the given due dates. Abstracts/full papers with poorly written English will not be considered.

7. Abstract/Full Paper Submission

Abstracts and/or full papers must be written according to the format given in the “Format Instruction (Item 5)” section, and “Type of Article (Item 4)” section. The abstract and full paper submission must be made via email to <ICADA4papers@gmail.com> within the given due dates and as the attached file(s) in the MS Word format only. **The maximum length of both an abstract is 150 words and that of a full paper is 4,000 words (excluding tables, appendices, and references).** The samples of the abstracts (Abstracts of the 7th ICADA 2018) and the full papers (The Proceedings of the 6th ICADA 2017) is available at <www.ICADA2018.nida.ac.th>.

8. Terms and Conditions of Participation in the Conference

The authors of the qualified abstracts and/or full papers to be presented at the conference must (1) register for participating in the conference by the due date and (2) present their work(s) in English in person on the date and time (designated by the conference committee). If they are unable to do so, they will not receive credit for their contribution and their full papers (if submitted) will not appear in the Proceedings.

The Proceedings of the conference will be published in the format of an Electronic book (E-book) with an International Standard Book Number (ISBN), which will be available on the website after the dates of the conference (October 2019, or later, tentatively).

9.1 The presenter(s)/author(s) must register and there is no charge.

9.2 The conditions for those who are non-presenters/authors are applied below.

(a) The non-presenters/authors who are faculty members, researchers, students and/or the employees of the public and private enterprises may observe the conference without fee by presenting their official IDs issued by their affiliations (e.g., Thammasart University employee's ID card). This fee entry will be processed on a case-by-case basis. The committee reserves rights on this matter.

3. Any accepted full paper shall be included in the Proceedings. The author(s) of those papers also cannot withdraw the paper(s) from being included in the Proceedings, and the same penalty will be applied.
4. Any follow ups absolutely are the authors' sole responsibility. An inquiry can be made to the ICADA Team, if the authors have not received feedbacks on their submissions or registration in timely fashion.
5. The author(s) is/are solely responsible for the submission process if any loss or missing occurs.
6. The editorial team reserves rights on any changes/updates of the submission process and instructions without notice. The author(s) must be alert on any possible or unexpected changes/dates.
